NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Customer Service counter located in the District's new Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 2:00:00 p.m., local time, on September 15, 2011, for construction of EMERGENCY REPAIR CONTRACT SERVICES. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids received after 2:00:00 p.m. will be deemed late. Immediately after the Bid closing time, timely Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A prebid conference will commence at 2:00:00 p.m., local time on September 2, 2011 in the District's new Administrative Building. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes: Emergency repair services to District infrastructure. The work consists of notifying One Call; contacting utilities; obtaining permits; bypass pumping; planning, setting, and removal of barricades; cutting asphalt; excavation; compacting backfill; surface restoration; repair of wastewater collection and/or treatment facilities, and repair of potable and non-potable water lines at times and locations directed by the District. Work may be required any time of day and any day of the year. Work shall start within two (2) hours of receiving a Work Change Directive from the District and continue until complete unless otherwise directed by the District.

The Site of the Work is located at: Public rights-of-way in which the District owns or operates wastewater facilities or properties owned by the District. Work sites may be anywhere in Clark County including Laughlin, Searchlight, Overton, and Blue Diamond.

Project Partnering shall be required for this project as specified in Section 01 31 21.

The Bidder to whom a Notice of Award is presented shall execute a written contract with OWNER on the form of the Agreement provided, shall secure all insurance, and shall furnish all certificates and Bonds required by the Specifications within 10 calendar days after receipt of the Notice of Award from OWNER. Notice to Proceed shall be issued within 10 days after the agreement is signed. The term of the Contract will be for one (1) year from the date of Award.

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The District reserves the option for two (2) additional Contract renewals in one (1) year periods. The District also reserves the option, for any reason, to temporarily extend this Contract for up to 90 days.

Shipping costs for the CD shall be paid for by the Bidder. Charge for shipping by regular mail is \$5. Shipping by overnight delivery requires Bidder to provide a shipper's account number. Bids shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee in the form of a cashier's or a certified check, cash, or Bidder's Bond in an amount not less than 10 percent of the Bid, made payable to or for the benefit of the District.
