NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Clark County Water Reclamation District
(CCWRD)

is soliciting proposals from qualified PROPOSERS for a **Performance
Contract
for Energy Cost Savings & Renewable Energy Projects.**

Proposals will be received by CCWRD, Attn: Stan Baldwin, **Design & Construction Services**, at the new Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, NV, 89122 on, or before, the Proposal Receipt Date of **January 12, 2012**, at or before the Proposal Submittal Time of **2:00:00 p.m.** local time for the **Performance Contract for Energy Cost Savings & Renewable Energy Projects**. A Pre-Proposal Conference/Site Visit is scheduled for **October 20, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.** local time at the CCWRD facility noted above. Attendance at this Conference is MANDATORY. Proposals must be time clock recorded upon receipt at or before the Proposal Submittal Time on the Proposal Receipt Date. Proposals received after the Proposal Submittal Time and Date will be deemed late. Proposals may not be withdrawn after the closing time.

Requests for interpretation, clarification and/or additional information must be received in writing no later than 4:30 p.m. local time, on December 1, 2011. Questions that, at the discretion and judgment of CCWRD require a response, and/or any changes to the RFP will be by way of addendum that will be made available on the CCWRD website at: www.cleanwaterteam.com/bid.

All proposals must be submitted in a sealed envelope or box plainly marked:

“Clark County Water Reclamation District – Performance Contract for Energy Cost Savings & Renewable Energy Projects”, with the name and address of the PROPOSER in the upper left hand corner, and accompanied by complete specifications for the items offered, marked and delivered to the **ATTENTION: STAN BALDWIN, CCWRD.**

Selected PROPOSERS may be asked to present their proposals and/or to demonstrate their ability to provide services requested in the RFP to CCWRD representatives at the facility noted above. PROPOSERS shall bear all costs for proposal preparation and any presentations requested.

The CCWRD seeks to maximize energy cost savings, water savings, and related operational savings in order to pay for facility upgrades, improvements and services; and to develop cost effective renewable energy projects.

AWARD will be made on the basis of PROPOSERS' qualifications and respective proposal for cost savings measures and renewable energy projects recommended, as judged by CCWRD to generate significant cost savings, and the best combination of proposed cost effective renewable energy projects, and be in the best interest of the public overall, each factor being considered.

CCWRD strongly encourages all PROPOSERS to consider the utilization of local, small, minority, women-owned, veterans, physically challenged, and disadvantaged businesses, suppliers, service providers, consultants, and contractors in all of its projects and proclaims its continuing efforts and desires that these businesses be provided the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of this Project.

CCWRD is committed to promoting full and equal business opportunities for all persons doing business in Clark County. The successful PROPOSER acknowledges that CCWRD has an obligation to ensure that public funds are not used to subsidize private discrimination. The successful PROPOSER recognizes that if they or their subcontractors are found guilty by an appropriate authority of refusing to hire or do business with an individual or company due to reasons of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression, age, disability, national origin, or any other protected status, CCWRD may declare the successful PROPOSER in breach of contract, terminate contract, and designate the successful PROPOSER as non-responsible.
