INVITATION TO BID AND LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Security Desk located at the main entrance of the District's Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 10:00 a.m., prevailing local time, on July 8, 2009, for Emergency Repair Contract Services. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids time stamped after 10:00 a.m. will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

A prebid conference will commence at 10:00 a.m., prevailing local time on June 22, 2009, at the District's conference room. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes: The work provides for emergency repair services to District infrastructure. The work consists of notifying One Call; contacting utilities; obtaining permits; bypass pumping; planning, setting, and removal of barricades; cutting asphalt; excavation; compacting backfill; surface restoration; and repair of wastewater collection and/or treatment facilities, at times and locations directed by the District. Work may be required any time of day and any day of the year. Work shall start within two (2) hours of receiving notice from the District and continue until complete unless otherwise directed by the District.

All work will be sited in public rights-of-way in which the District owns or operates waste water facilities or properties owned by the District. Work sites may be anywhere in Clark County including Laughlin, Searchlight, Moapa Valley, Indian Springs, and Blue Diamond.

Physical Notice to Proceed must be reached within 10 Days of Administrative Notice to Proceed. The term of the Contract will be for one (1) year from the date of Award. The District reserves the option to renew this Contract for an additional three (3) years in one (1) year periods from its expiration date. The District also reserves the option, for any reason, to temporarily extend this Contract for up to 90 days from its expiration date.

Immediately after the Bid closing time, the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the District's conference room.

For bonding purposes, the budget estimate for this project is between \$2,500,000 and \$3,500,000.

The OWNER will not award the Contract to a person who at the time of the Bid is not and for the past five (5) years has not been properly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 624 of NRS or if the Contract would exceed the limit of the Bidder's license. The Bidder's Nevada State Contractor's license number, classification, etc. must be shown on the Bid Form.

The OWNER will not award the Contract to a person who does not meet the experience requirements as stated in the Bid Documents.

Bidders shall guarantee their Bids for a period of ninety (90) Days after Bid opening.

Bid Documents may be examined and obtained from DESIGN CONSULTANT as shown above by making a nonrefundable payment of \$50.00 per set. Make checks payable to Carollo Engineers.

Bids shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee in the form of a cashier's or a certified check, cash, or Bidder's Bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the Bid, made payable to or for the benefit of the Clark County Water Reclamation District.

Neither OWNER/ENGINEER or DESIGN CONSULTANT have any responsibility for the accuracy, completeness or sufficiency of any Bid Documents obtained from any source other than the source indicated in these documents. Obtaining these documents from any other source(s) may result in obtaining incomplete and inaccurate information. You are hereby advised that obtaining these documents from any source other than directly from the source listed herein may also result in your failure to receive any addenda, corrections, or other revisions to these documents that may be issued.

PLEASE NOTE, COMPLIANCE WITH NRS 338.144 IS REQUIRED FOR THIS PROJECT. REFER TO SECTION 29 OF THE INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

The Bidder to whom the OWNER awards the Contract and Subcontractors will be bound by federal, state, and local laws regarding minimum wages, overtime Work, hiring, and discrimination, including NRS 338.020 through NRS 090. Bidders are responsible to identify and use the correct prevailing wage rates, including any addenda as well as the forms needed to comply, as specified by the State of Nevada Labor Commissioner.

OWNER'S RIGHTS RESERVED: The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality in a Bid, and to make Award to the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder, as it may best serve the interest of the OWNER.
