NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Security Desk located at the main entrance of the District's Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 2:00 p.m., prevailing local time, on June 18, 2009, for construction of MOAPA VALLEY COLLECTION SYSTEM GRAVITY SEWER. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids time stamped after 2:00 p.m. will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

A prebid conference will commence at 11:00 a.m., prevailing local time on May 20, 2009, at the District's conference room. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes:

Base Bid: Construction of new facilities from Station 254+89 to Station 445+48 and the Yamashita Bridge crossing which include approximately 21,100 linear feet of sanitary sewer in diameters of 8, 10, 12, 15, 24, 30, and 36 inches; 54 manholes in diameters of 48-inch, 60-inch, and 72-inch; relocation of existing utilities; abandoning irrigation facilities; connection of existing sewers to new sewers; pavement replacement; traffic control; service laterals and appurtenances; and all other improvements and ancillary work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Additive Alternate A: If awarded at OWNER's option, construction of new facilities from Station 211+08 to Station 254+89 which include approximately 4,600 linear feet of sanitary sewer in diameters of 8 and 24 inches; 10 manholes in diameter of 48-inch; relocation of existing utilities; abandoning irrigation facilities; pavement replacement; traffic control; service laterals and appurtenances; and all other improvements and ancillary work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Additive Alternate B: If awarded at OWNER's option in lieu of Additive Alternate A, construction of new facilities from Station 211+08 to Station 254+89 which include approximately 4,600 linear feet of sanitary sewer in diameters of 8 and 12 inches; 10 manholes in diameter of 48-inch; relocation of existing utilities; abandoning irrigation facilities; pavement replacement; traffic control; service laterals and appurtenances; and all other improvements and ancillary work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

NOTE TO BIDDER: Design drawings for new facilities between Station 211+08 and Station 9+49, listed in this paragraph, are provided for reference only and are not included with the construction of this project. The reference drawings include approximately 21,200 linear feet of sanitary sewer in diameters of 8, 10, 15, 18, 20, and 24 inches; 61 manholes in diameters of 48-inch and 60-inch; relocation of existing utilities; abandoning irrigation facilities; pavement replacement; traffic control; service laterals, bioxide chemical feed and storage system, and appurtenances.

The Site of the Work is located at: Moapa Valley, Overton, and Logandale, Nevada.

Physical Notice to Proceed (PNTP) must be reached within 90 Days of Administrative Notice to Proceed (ANTP). If only the Base Bid is awarded, the Work must be Substantially Complete within 302 Days after the ANTP. For the Base Bid, the Work must reach Final Completion within 392 Days after the ANTP. If the Base Bid and Additive Alternate A are awarded, the Work must be Substantially Complete within 381 Days after the ANTP. For the Base Bid and Additive Alternate A, the Work must reach Final Completion within 471 Days after the ANTP date.

For bonding purposes, the budget estimate for this project is as follows:

Base Bid: between \$ 17,500,000 and \$ 21,500,000.  
Additive Alternate A: between \$ 3,000,000 and \$ 4,000,000.  
Additive Alternate B: between \$ 1,000,000 and \$ 2,000,000.

The OWNER will not award the Contract to a person who at the time of the Bid is not properly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 624 of NRS or if the Contract would exceed the limit of the Bidder's license. The Bidder's Nevada State Contractor's license number, classification, etc. must be shown on the Bid Form.

Bidders shall guarantee their Bids for a period of ninety (90) Days after Bid opening.


ADDENDUM NO. 2 VOLUME ONE - FRONT END DOCUMENTS
