NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Customer Service counter located at the main entrance of the District's New Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 2:00:00 PM (hour:minutes:seconds), Pacific Standard Time (PST), on December 3, 2009, for construction of Upgrade of the Indian Springs Collection and Treatment System. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids time stamped after 2:00:00 PM PST will be returned to the Bidder unopened. Immediately after the Bid closing time, the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

This project is being constructed with funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). Bidders must comply with the ARRA requirements.

**ALL BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE AND SITE TOUR.**

- THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE WILL COMMENCE AT 10:00:00 A.M., PST ON OCTOBER 29, 2009, AT THE INDIAN SPRINGS COMMUNITY CENTER, 719 W GRETTA LANE, INDIAN SPRINGS, NV 89018.
- THE SITE TOUR WILL COMMENCE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE PREBID CONFERENCE. BIDDERS INTERESTED IN ATTENDING THE SITE TOUR MUST REGISTER IN ADVANCE BY CALLING MS. MARIE OXLEY AT (702) 668-8142 BY OCTOBER 23, 2009. ATTENDEES WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FULL NAMES AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS FOR AIR FORCE SECURITY CLEARANCE. BUSES WILL DEPART FOR TOURS ONTO CREECH AFB AND DISTRICT PROPERTY. THIS TOUR WILL BE THE ONLY OPPORTUNITY TO ACCESS THE CREECH AFB AS INDIVIDUAL TOURS WILL NOT BE ARRANGED.

The Work on Creech Air Force Base includes:

1. Demolition of the existing wastewater treatment plant.
2. Construction of a new lift station, 5,520 feet of 6-inch diameter forcemain, 880 feet of 15-inch diameter gravity sewer, grading, and appurtenances.

The Work in Indian Springs includes:

1. Construction of new 0.5 million gallon per day (MGD) mechanical secondary treatment plant, conversion of existing treatment lagoons to percolation ponds, installation of two new percolation ponds, constructing new blower/electrical building, associated mechanical and electrical work, driveway entrance improvements, new SCADA system, new security system, and yard piping.
2. Upgrade the existing District lift station near the Indian Springs Casino.

3. Installing 6,200 feet of utilities including 8-inch diameter and 10-inch diameter forcemains, potable water pressure pipe and fiber optic cables.
4. Construction of NV Energy electrical power supply system for Indian Springs lift station and treatment plant along US Highway 95.
5. Tunneling under US Highway 95 to install 253 feet of new 18-inch sewer in a casing.
6. Install 455 feet of 18-inch diameter sewer around a gas station and reconnect the lateral to new sewer.
7. Associated work includes grading, abandoning existing sewers, remove and replace manholes, install new manholes, environmental monitoring/protection, and appurtenances.

The Site of the Work is located at: Indian Springs, Nevada and includes Work on the Creech Air Force Base, the Indian Springs Casino parking lot, and along the north side of US Highway 95.

Physical Notice to Proceed (PNTP) must be reached within 120 Days of Administrative Notice to Proceed (ANTP), and the Work must be Substantially Complete within 310 Days after the commencement date stated in the PNTP. The Work must reach Final Completion within 430 days after the ANTP date.
