INVITATION TO BID AND LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Security Desk located at the main entrance of the District's Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 1:00 P.M., prevailing local time, on November 20, 2008, for construction of the Crosstown Interceptor Rehabilitation Project No. 2. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids time stamped after 1:00 P.M. will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

A prebid conference will commence at 10:00 A.M., prevailing local time on November 10, 2008, at the District's conference room. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes: This project consists of the rehabilitation and installation of existing sanitary sewer pipes and manholes and the relocation of an existing waterline. The rehabilitation of pipelines will utilize "trenchless" technology by inserting a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) inside the existing reinforced concrete pipe with integral T-Lock liner. The rehabilitation work includes the rehabilitation of existing manholes and the rehabilitation of approximately 1,664 LF of 36-inch diameter pipe, 10 LF of 48-inch diameter pipe, 12,439 LF of 60-inch diameter pipe. The new installation work includes installing manholes and centrifugally cast fiberglass reinforced pipe (CCFRP) with a wye connection to the existing Crosstown Interceptor at Harmon Avenue and Koval Lane. Approximately 84 LF of 60-inch diameter pipe and 22 LF of 48-inch diameter pipe will extend south in Koval Lane, where the pipeline will connect to an existing line and also be stubbed for future connection. The relocation work consists of abandoning approximately 65 LF of 8-inch diameter asbestos cement pipe and replacing with approximately 120 LF of 8-inch diameter ductile iron pipe, using two hot taps. Other major items of Work will include traffic control, bypassing and diversion of sewage flow, odor control, maintaining service to customers, cleaning of existing pipes and disposing of debris, post-cleaning CCTV inspection, post-lining CCTV inspection, reinstatement of service laterals, and pavement removal and replacement.

The Site of the Work is located at the following locations in the Clark County Water Reclamation District's system: Koval Lane between Tropicana Avenue and Harmon Avenue, Harmon Avenue between Audrie Street and Swenson Street, Harmon Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Pearl Street, and Pearl Street between Harmon Avenue and Flamingo Road. The project areas are located within the public rights-of-way of Clark County, Nevada, NDOT, the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, and private property.

Physical Notice to Proceed must be reached within 60 Days of Administrative Notice to Proceed, and the Work must be Substantially Complete by January 29, 2010. The Work must reach Final Completion by March 1, 2010.

For bonding purposes, the budget estimate for this project is between \$ 13,000,000 and \$ 15,000,000.

The OWNER will not award the Contract to a person who at the time of the Bid is not properly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 624 of NRS or if the Contract would exceed the limit of the Bidder's license. The Bidder's Nevada State Contractor's license number, classification, etc. must be shown on the Bid Form.

Bidders shall guarantee their Bids for a period of ninety (90) Days after Bid opening.
