NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Customer Service counter located in the District's new Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 2:00:00 p.m., local time, on March 3, 2011, for construction of Corrosion Management Plan Phase 2 Bid Package No. 3. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids received after 2:00:00 p.m. will be deemed late. Immediately after the Bid closing time, timely Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A prebid conference will commence at 10:30 a.m. local time on February 3, 2011 in the District's new Administrative Building. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes: Rehabilitation of concrete in 90-foot diameter Flow Equalization Basins #1 and #2, including lining the wall and columns with an embedded PVC liner cast into a new concrete wall section, epoxy coating of the ceiling, access covers in the reinforced concrete ceiling, CCTV inspection of the 24-inch and 30-inch overflow pipelines, and possible CIPP rehabilitation of the overflow pipelines. The rehabilitation of the existing Alum Flocc Clarifier by replacing all existing components in the basin including but not limited to the draft tubes, rotating hood, rotor and rotor drive, scraper and scraper drive, launders, bridge/walkway, internal support steel. Removal and disposal of the existing galvanized steel deck roof on the Screening Building and replacement of the roof with a stainless steel deck roof per the plans and specifications on the Screening Building and providing coating to the existing steel framing. Removal and disposal of the existing galvanized steel HVAC ductwork and equipment at the Screening Building, Flow Equalization Building, Blower Building, Filter building, DAFT Building, and Solids Building. Replacement of eight of the existing evaporative coolers of equivalent capability. Replacement of the roof membranes at the Switch Gear Building, Recycle Pumping Building, Blower Building, Solids Processing Building, and DAFT Building. Replacing all exterior sealants in joints.
