INVITATION TO BID AND LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Clark County Water Reclamation District invites and will receive sealed Bids at the Security Desk located at the main entrance of the District's Administration Building, 5857 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122, at or before the hour of 2:00 p.m., prevailing local time, on October 9, 2008, for construction of SLOAN INERCEPTOR REHABILITATION. Bids will be received and time clock recorded by the District's Purchasing and Contracts representative. Bids time stamped after 2:00 p.m. will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

A prebid conference will commence at 10:00 a.m., prevailing local time on September 26, 2008, at the District's conference room. It is strongly recommended that all interested Bidders attend the prebid conference.

The Work includes:

1. Rehabilitation of the following RCP and VCP pipes and manholes:
 - a. Approximately 1.0 mile of mainly 30" RCP pipe and its associated manholes from Alcott Avenue to Vegas Valley Drive along South Sloan Lane.
 - b. Approximately 1.3 miles of 24" and 27" RCP and VCP pipes and its associated manholes from the intersection of Alcott Avenue and South Sloan Lane to the intersection of Stewart Avenue and North Sloan Lane along Foxglove Drive and Linn Lane.
 - c. Approximately 1.0 mile of mainly 24" RCP and VCP pipes and its associated manholes from the corner of Stewart Avenue and North Sloan Lane to the intersection of North Sloan Lane and East Washington Avenue.
 - d. Approximately 460 feet each of 8", 15", and 18" pipes at the 3-barrel inverted siphon across Las Vegas Wash, and coating of its associated structures.
2. Cleaning of the following PVC and HDPE pipes:
 - a. Approximately 300 feet of 30" PVC pipe located South of East Charleston Blvd.
 - b. Approximately 650 feet of 27" PVC pipe located on East Sahara Avenue, East of South Sloan Lane.
 - c. Approximately 73 feet of 30" HDPE pipe located South of Vegas Valley Drive.

3. System information was retrieved from previous CCTV and includes lengths, diameters, and materials. Aerial photos and site investigations were also used to prepare the Drawings and are representative of the best information available at the time of bid. CONTRACTOR shall field-verify information to accurately perform the Work.
4. Major items of Work include the following:
 - Traffic control
 - Bypassing and diversion of flow
 - Odor control
 - Cleaning of existing pipe
 - Post-cleaning CCTV inspection
 - Lining existing pipes
 - Post-lining CCTV inspection
 - Reinstatement of service laterals
5. All pipes shall be lined with cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) technology regardless of their initial condition. All manholes shall be rehabilitated regardless of their initial condition either by lining it or by replacing part or the entirety of the manhole.

The Site of the Work is located at: Sloan Lane between Washington Avenue and Vegas Valley Drive.

Physical Notice to Proceed must be reached within 90 Days of Administrative Notice to Proceed, and the Work must be Substantially Complete within 270 Days after the commencement date stated in the Physical Notice To Proceed. The Work must reach Final Completion within 330 Days after the commencement date.

For bonding purposes, the budget estimate for this project is between \$ 4,000,000 and \$ 5,000,000.

The OWNER will not award the Contract to a person who at the time of the Bid is not properly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 624 of NRS or if the Contract would exceed the limit of the Bidder's license. The Bidder's Nevada State Contractor's license number, classification, etc. must be shown on the Bid Form.

Bidders shall guarantee their Bids for a period of ninety (90) Days after Bid opening.
