Immediately after the Bid closing time, timely Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Work includes: Approximately 6,900 linear feet of sewer pipelines in 4 locations throughout unincorporated Clark County. Diameter of sewers ranges from 8 inches to 24 inches. Work will include construction of new manholes and laterals, modifications to existing manholes and laterals, pavement replacement, traffic control, bypass pumping operations, and all other improvements and ancillary work, in accordance with the Contract Documents. Project will also include rehabilitation of existing CCWRD infrastructure in 8 locations in Clark County. Rehabilitations will include cleaning, pipeline inspections, cured-in-place pipe liners, cured-in-place manhole liners, new manhole construction, manhole base rehabilitation, sewer relocations, waterline relocations, traffic control, bypass pumping operations, and all other improvements and ancillary work, in accordance with the Contract Documents.
