

## Sewer Service Rates and SDA Fees

Following are the sewer service rates and SDA fees, as approved by the Clark County Water Reclamation District Board of Trustees.

The Clark County Water Reclamation District uses a universal rate system, where all service areas are charged the same annual amount for sewer service fees, per ERU. The universal rate structure also applies to SDA fees, with the exception of connections in Laughlin and customers converting from private septic systems.

Amounts listed are charged per ERU (Equivalent Residential Unit, or Single Family Residence). In addition to the annual sewer service charge, each account is assessed a \$16.00 annual service fee. A \$12.00 discount is given to all accounts paid –in-full by July 31<sup>st</sup>.

### POOLS

Customers with pools, which include swimming pools, non-residential spas, decorative fountains, waterscapes, lagoons, spas and hot tubs will have an additional charge added to the annual charge.

Pool charges are based upon total gallons, regardless of the number of pools. For 20,000 gallons or less, the charge is 10% of the annual sewer service charge. For each additional 20,000 gallons, or fraction thereof, an additional 10% of the annual service charge will be assessed.
