**RULES FOR SEWER SERVICE**

All system development approval (SDA) charges are due and payable in advance. SDAs must be obtained and paid for prior to obtaining a building permit. If SDA is for a commercial (non-residential) structure, a copy of construction plumbing/architectural/kitchen plans must be submitted to the Clark County Water Reclamation District (CCWRD). Construction must commence within one (1) year of issuance of the SDA, except in areas covered by presell resolutions where construction must commence within three (3) months of issuance of the SDA, or the SDA becomes void.

All construction must comply with CCWRD Design and Construction Standards. Every separate structure must have a separate connection to the sewer main. Inspection of lateral installation(s) will be required. Release of certificates of occupancy will not be authorized until all discrepancies, if found, are resolved. Under no circumstances will CCWRD authorize release of occupancy permits for property that has not been inspected and had all applicable charges paid.

All facilities which discharge wastewater to the District collection system must comply fully with all Federal, State, and local pretreatment standards. Any on-site pumping facilities must comply with District discharge standards.

CCWRD reserves the right to conduct a physical inspection of all commercial structures upon completion of construction for the purpose of determining actual billing units (ERUs) in place. If the number of ERUs found during inspection differs from those counted from the plans, paid for, an adjustment in system development charges may be made. If SDA fees are based on estimated water usage, additional fees may be required upon verification of actual water usage as determined by the appropriate water provider. Removal of fixtures may be necessary if treatment plant or collection system capacity is limited. If additional ERUs are found, SDA charges will be due and payable upon and shall be paid at the rate in effect at the date of discovery by CCWRD. Additionally, CCWRD may periodically, but is not required to, inspect the premises for any changes of the type of business conducted, quality of wastewater discharged, and to determine the number of billing units/ERUs. All additional ERUs shall be billed to the legal owner of the property.
